Session 1: March 28 6:30-8:30pm

Eucharist—God’s Love as Nourishment in Jesus Christ

Session 2: April 4 6:30-8:30pm

Eucharist—God’s Love as Reconciliation in Jesus Christ

Session 3: April 11 6:30-8:30pm

Eucharist—God’s Love as Transformation in Jesus Christ
